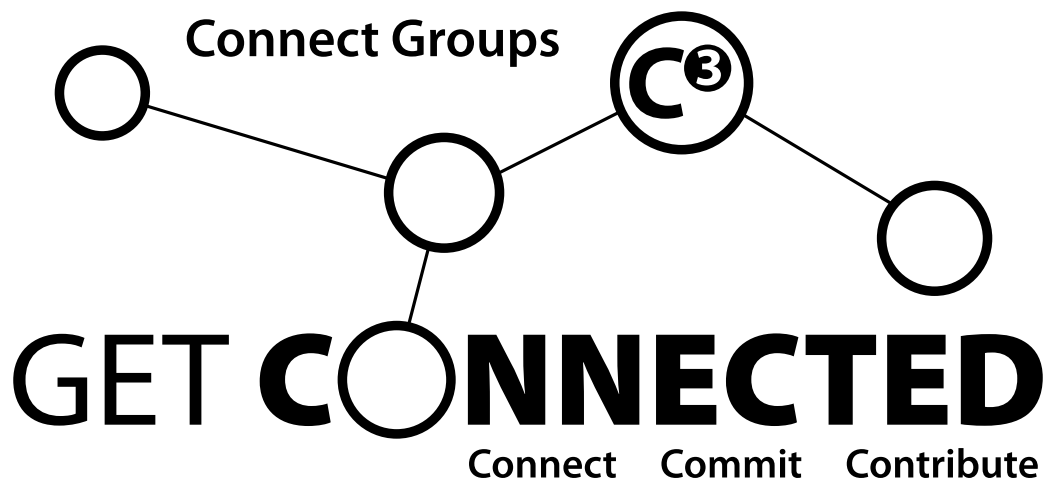

# Top 10 List of FAQs About Connect Groups

## 1. What is a connect group?

A connect group is 4-12 people who want to connect relationally, have a good time and experience personal growth together.

## 2. Who can participate in connect groups?

Everyone. Connect groups exist for various ages, needs and stages of your life. Please see the requirements section listed for each group.

## 3. Do I have to know a lot about the Bible to be in a group?

No! The primary focus of connect groups is to connect with others, to grow in our walk with God and strengthen the expression of our faith.

## 4. Can I participate in more than one group?

Yes! If you have time for more than one group, that's great.

## 5. Where do the connect groups meet?

In homes, church, outdoors, restaurants...there are numerous possibilities where groups may meet.

## 6. When do the connect groups meet?

Each group sets its own schedule. Groups are encouraged to meet weekly or bi-weekly. The study or activities of a connect group should start and end within the semester time frame.

## 7. How do I get signed up with a connect group?

You can sign up at the Ministry Fair prior to each semester or contact the group leader using the information contained in this directory.

## 8. How much will the connect group cost me?

Cost will vary with each group. Every effort is made to keep costs to a minimum. See requirement section for each group.

## 9. Is childcare provided?

Some connect groups offer childcare, others do not. Some group members pool together to hire a babysitter or care for each other's children on a rotating basis. Please contact the leader of the group you are interested in for specific information.

## 10. Can I invite a guest to a connect group?

Yes, in most cases. Contact the group leader for specific information.

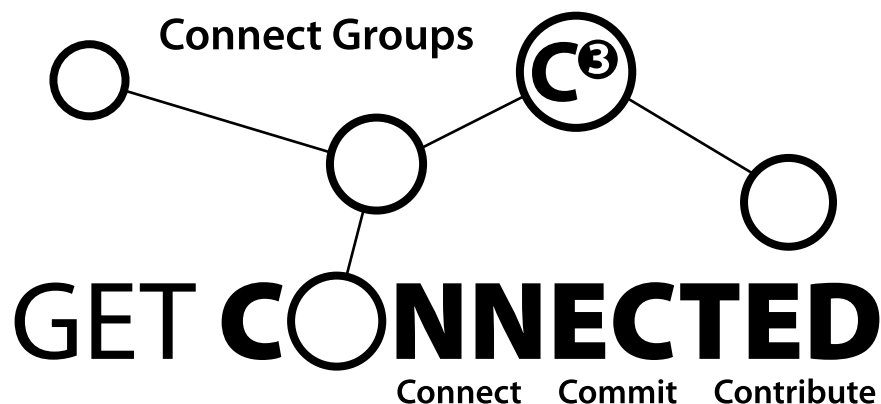

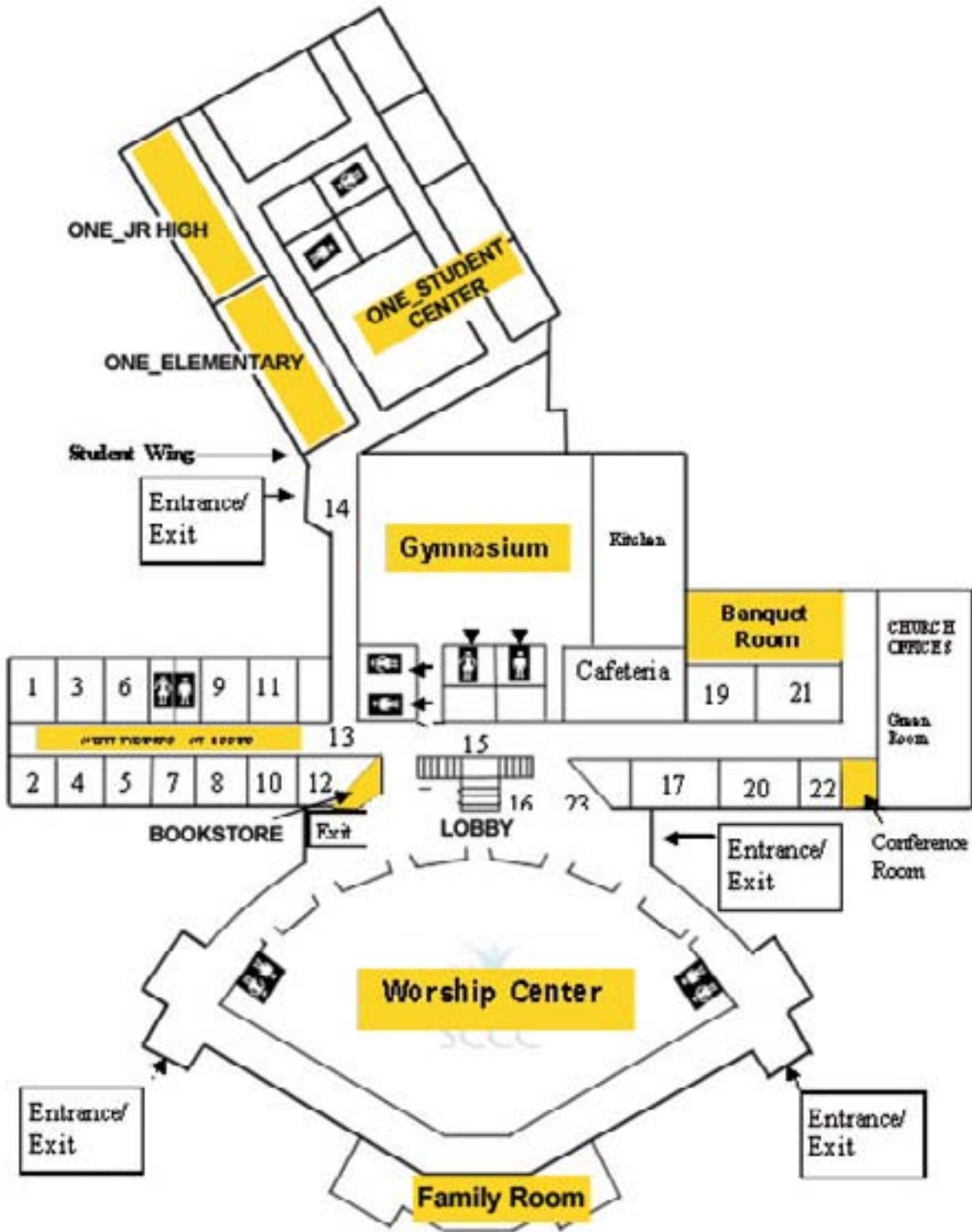
